Five friends dreamed of multiplying the impact of their individual giving, so they created IMPACT GIVING, a women's collective giving organization dedicated to effecting positive social change and transforming lives in our communities, our nation, and around the world.

Today, we are more than 115 women who have awarded 81 grants to 45 nonprofits, both locally and globally, totaling \$1.6 million.

We provide opportunities for connectedness amongst our Partners and with our grant recipients.

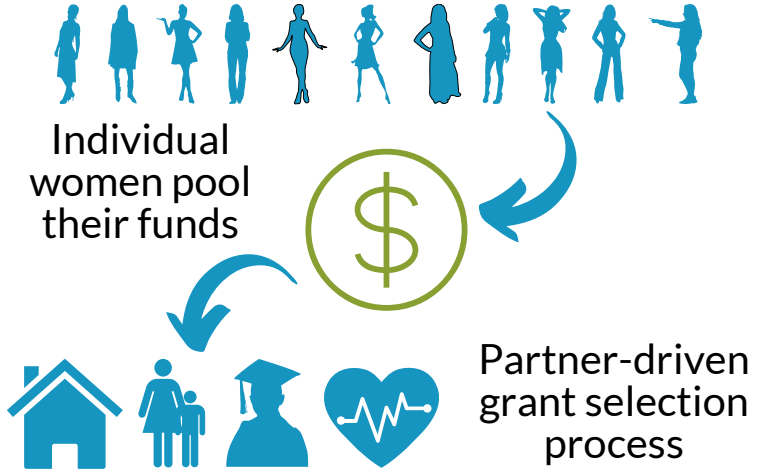

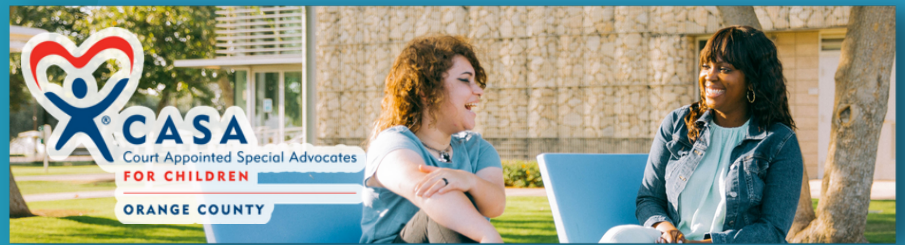


2022 GRANT RECIPIENTS



\$30,000 GRANT

Funds will be used to conduct 2-3 events each month in each city Be Well OC serves (Huntington Beach, Garden Grove, Anaheim; soon Newport Beach and Irvine; with 5 more cities by the end of the year) to build relationships with schools, community organizations, churches, senior centers, etc. The goal is to build awareness of this vital resource, and thus utilization when people are in crisis.



\$30,000 GRANT

CASA provides a powerful voice for youth in the child welfare system through a unique one-on-one relationship with trained and supervised court appointed volunteer advocates. The funds will be used to recruit, screen and train 200 new CASAs through CASAs advocate training program.

\$15,000 GRANT

ElderHelp provides personalized services and information that help seniors live independently and age with dignity in their own homes. Project will help serve an anticipated 464 clients, including 200 seniors with bi-weekly food deliveries and an additional 264 clients living in low-income senior housing.



\$15,000 GRANT

The goal of Dragon Kim Foundation is to inspire our youth to impact their communities while discovering and pursuing their passions. Funds will be used to expand their fellowship program from 62 students with 28 service projects in 2021 to 75 students and 32 projects in 2022. This grant would provide funding for the additional students and increase support for disadvantaged students.



\$25,000 GRANT

WISEPlace leads the effort of ending homelessness for unaccompanied women through housing solutions and empowering wrap-around services that provide a path toward personal self-reliance. Grant will fund the legal advocate's salary and low cost/high quality legal services out-sourced by WISEPlace on behalf of their clients.

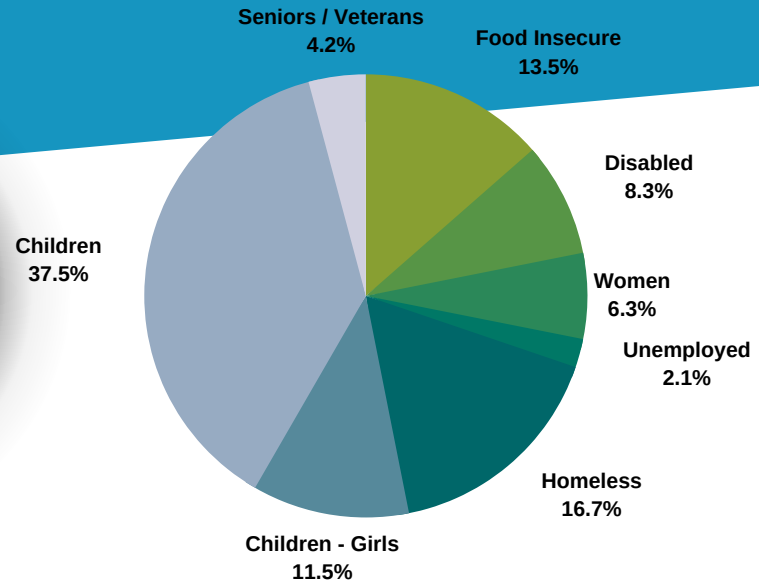

YEAR IN REVIEW 2021-2022

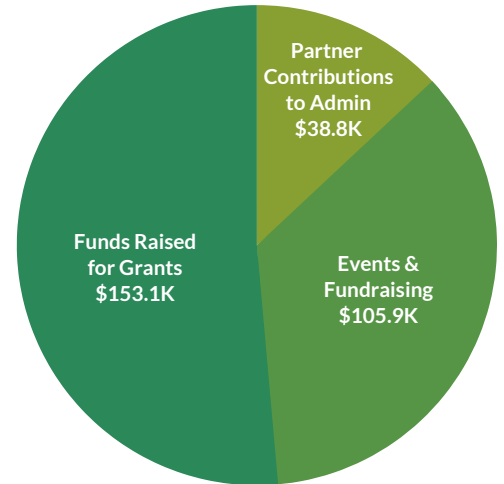
As our world continues to rebound from COVID-related challenges, we have joyously (yet cautiously) returned to several successful in-person events.

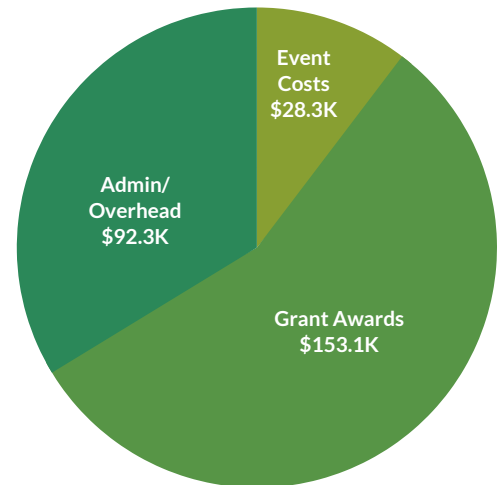
