What a year 2019 has been! Thank you to Impact Giving's Partners and contributors as we celebrate a decade of experiencing the power of women and the impact of collective giving. In those 10 years, we have helped us award \$1.3 million through 65 grants to local and global nonprofit organizations.



In 2019, Impact Giving grants supported:

- The purchase of a new Cleveland Tilt Brazier for Bracken's Kitchen, which has helped provide over 150,000 additional healthy meals for the hungry people of Orange County
- Training for 296 Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA), who support 296 transitional age foster care youth, providing guidance, education, life skills and a consistent presence as they move to self-sufficiency
- 4 of 20 Dragon Kim Foundation fellowship teams that provide youth leadership training and 1-1 mentoring to a diverse group of 41 young adults looking to better their community in Orange County
- The launch of the Corneal Blindness Prevention Program in 2 districts of Nepal, providing cutting-edge corneal blindness prevention programs and health education with the help of 142 female volunteers through SightLife
- The building of local well in Kenya, in partnership with The Samburu Project, to help improve the lives of over 1,000 women, children and families, as well as providing education to about 150 women on health, leadership, the importance of education and rights to equality
- The renovation of Warrior Foundation Freedom Station II, which is a transitional housing opportunity for warriors who sustained injuries in Iraq and Afghanistan.

My heartfelt gratitude is extended to those who continue to make Impact Giving a priority in their busy lifestyles. We are excited about the growth of Impact Giving and look forward to further grow our organization over the next decade. The amazing work we have achieved over the years would not be possible without all of our supporter's passion, dedication, and hard work.

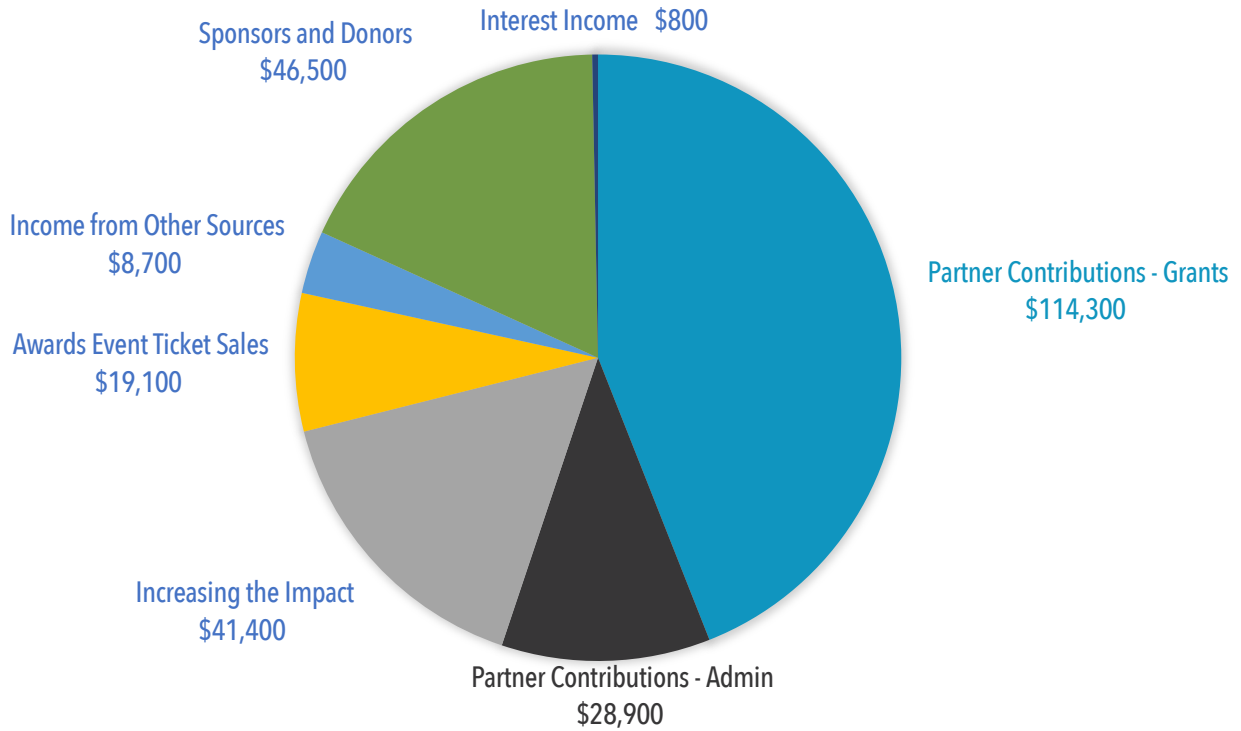

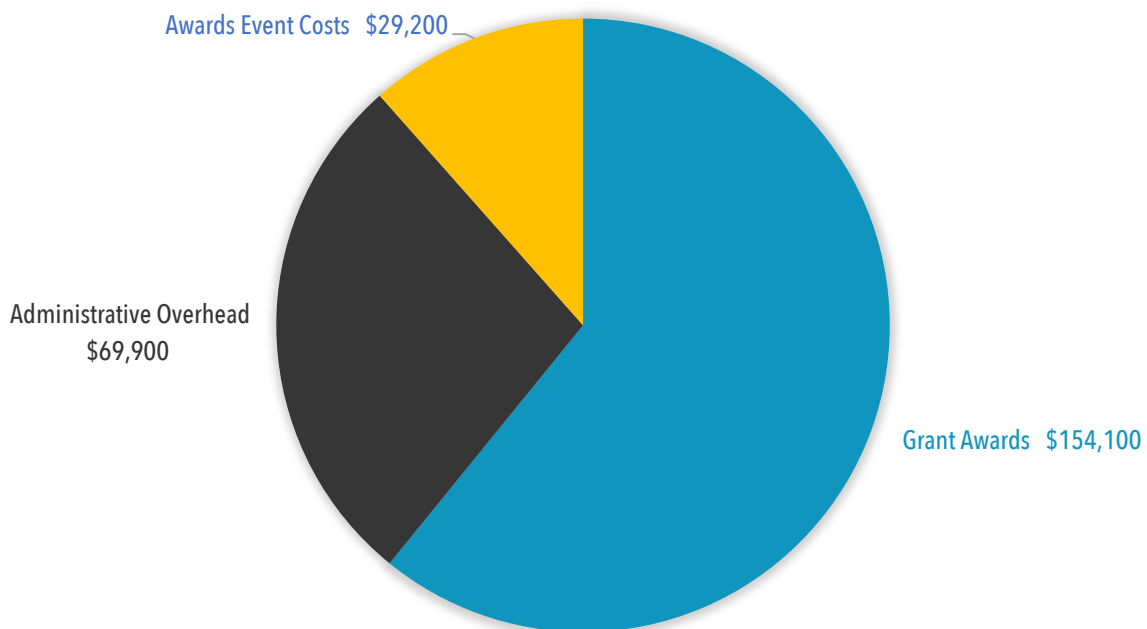
REVENUE – FISCAL YEAR 2019: \$259,700*

\$25,000 GRANT

Corneal blindness is a preventable loss of sight caused by damage to the surface of the eye. It is particularly prevalent and devastating in developing countries. SightLife is currently running two cutting-edge corneal blindness prevention programs in Nepal and India. An Impact Giving grant funded two new sites outside of Katmandu.



**WARRIOR FOUNDATION
FREEDOM STATION®**

\$25,000 GRANT

Funds are being used in the building of Freedom Station II in San Diego, which will provide transitional housing to warriors who have sustained injuries in Iraq and Afghanistan, and are either active duty or recently medically retired military personnel.

100 wells and counting!

\$24,400 GRANT

\$22,000 for a water well supporting and providing to a community of approximately 1000 people. \$2,400 provides Samburu Sisters Workshop (SSW) for that community. Mandatory hygiene and sanitation workshops are completed by each well community. SSW provides education for about 150 women on health, leadership, importance of education, rights to equality.



\$21,000 GRANT

Purchased a Cleveland Tilt Brazier with a 40-gallon capacity to create more stews and soups, a new hood and kitchen exhaust system build-out that facilitates cooking 90 chickens simultaneously (in an oven purchased with other funds) which allows them to meet 2019 goals to increase their food service program by 100%.





THE DRAGON KIM
FOUNDATION

\$20,000 GRANT

Funds are supporting the Dragon Kim Fellowship Program, providing financial support, leadership training, and 1-1 mentoring to a diverse group of 41 youth to develop and implement impactful community service projects estimated to serve over 2,000 underserved individuals within our community.



\$15,000 GRANT

CASA of OC currently has a waitlist of 225 foster children that are seeking the support of a specially trained advocate. The largest group are Transitional Age Youth (TAY). The money provided will directly correlate to an increase in the number of youth that are able to be served. Money will be used to train the CASAs, match them with youth, and provide direct support to CASAs by trained supervisors.
